

CYO Summer Sport Camp Confirmation continued:

**Emergency Information:** In case of an emergency, and you need to notify the camp and/or your child, please call the Portland office (503-231-9484) during our office hours which are 9:00am – 5:00pm, and you will be helped with your situation.

**Safety:** The safety and well-being of the campers is our top priority. We have first aid trained individuals at the camp to help with basic first aid issues.

**Behavior Expectations:** CYO/Camp Howard strives to provide a safe Christian community for all campers. Campers that are unwilling to follow the basic camp rules make it difficult for staff to provide this environment for all campers. It is unacceptable for one camper to ruin the experience of other campers. Campers are expected to follow all the rules of CYO/Camp Howard or they will be sent home. We will make every effort to work with your child, but if other children are being affected, or if their behavior is putting them or others at risk, then we will send the child home with no refund. Below is the code of conduct for CYO/Camp Howard participants:

1. Respect yourself
2. Respect others
3. Respect the environment
4. Respect the buildings and property of the location camp is being held at
5. Follow directions
6. Use proper language
7. Discrimination and intimidation will not be tolerated
8. Malicious teasing of another person is unacceptable
9. There is no place at camp for alcohol, drugs, fireworks, knives, weapons, sexual activity which includes holding hands and kissing, etc.
