CYO/CAMP HOWARD

CYO/Camp Howard is a tax-exempt organization that began in the Portland metropolitan area in 1946. The mission and purpose is: (1) to provide opportunities for youth of all race, nationality, or religion, to discover and be reassured of their self worth; (2) to assist youth in becoming valuable members of society through activities of a social, cultural, and recreational nature based on Christian principles that reinforce sound human and social values; and (3) from this awareness using their talents in service to people of their communities.

Through CYO, youth are given the opportunity to participate in the athletic programs including football, volleyball, basketball, swimming, track & field and cheerleading. These programs provide the youth opportunities to participate in activities under conditions that are safe, enjoyable, and promote Christian attitudes of fair play and cooperation. CYO has concern for the whole person made up of body, mind and spirit, encouraging the interests and needs of the individual for the total growth and development of the young person. Bringing youth together from different schools and social backgrounds in an atmosphere that fosters friendship with opponents and teaches principles of sportsmanship is an important aspect of CYO sports. **Developing the individual is the focus; the sport event is merely the tool.**

Camp Howard is situated on 244 acres of forestland approximately 35 miles east of Portland. Camp Howard's diverse program serves youth ages 8 to 14 years from all ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds. Camp Howard's activities include outdoor games, swimming, outdoor living education, and camaraderie within a group living environment. The purpose of the camp is to challenge and motivate each camper, and address the whole person-spiritual, emotional, physical and social-with special emphasis given to promoting the self-worth of each individual camper. The Board of Directors and the staff believe that providing young people with an environment that nurtures, and allows each to achieve success is the greatest gift to be given. Registrations to Camp Howard are open to all youth throughout the Pacific Northwest area. More than 15,000 youth have participated in the Camp Howard program during the past 15 years.

More than 12,000 youth (grades K-12) take part in CYO/Camp Howard programs each year; thus, making CYO/Camp Howard one of the largest youth organizations in Oregon. Financing for these programs is made possible by the collection of fees from the participants (97%) and by donations (3%), of this total amount, 92% of all money collected goes directly to the CYO/Camp Howard programs, and the remaining 8% to administrative services. This is proof of CYO's dedication to the youth of our community.
